ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

No. 15-AO-0003-P  
(Superseding 13-AO-0004-P)

Effective immediately, cases assigned to a District Judge, not in senior service, seeking judicial review of decisions by the Social Security Administration will be assigned as follows:

1. In cases where the parties consent to the exercise of jurisdiction by a United States Magistrate Judge in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the Clerk's Office will assign those cases to a United States Magistrate Judge on a rotational basis without regard to divisional assignments.

2. In cases where such consent has not been given, the case will be referred, upon completion of the briefing schedule, to a United States Magistrate Judge on a rotational basis without regard to divisional assignments for a report and recommendation, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B).

This Order supercedes Administrative Order 13-AO-04-P, dated December 9, 2013.
