**WAIVER OF DETENTION
HEARING**

Defendant states to the court as follows:

1. I understand that I have a right to a hearing, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3142(f), to determine whether I should be held in custody while awaiting trial or final revocation hearing, or whether I should be released on conditions that would reasonably assure my appearance and/or the safety of any other person and the community. I also understand that at that hearing, I would be entitled to the assistance of counsel and that I would have the opportunity to testify, to present information and witnesses, and to cross-examine witnesses who appear at the hearing.

2. I have discussed with my attorney *using an interpreter who speaks my primary language and English* my right to have a detention hearing as described above. My attorney has answered all questions I have regarding this matter. I understand that by giving up my right to a hearing, I will be held in custody while awaiting trial or final revocation hearing.

3. At this time, I wish to give up my right to have a detention hearing.
