Criminal Sealed Menu Instructions

Three new menus have been added to the Northern District of Iowa CM/ECF Criminal section for sealed events: Sealed Document – Docket Text Public; Sealed Document and Entry – No Public Access; and Sealed Document and Entry – Court Only Access.

The new menus consist of three levels of criminal sealed events. The criminal sealed events included in specific menus will not appear in any other menu.

The Search tab at the top of the screen is available if you are not sure where an event is located.



Enter a word from the name of the event you are searching for and click the Search button.




A list of events will appear that contain the word you searched for.




