PUBLIC NOTICE FOR REAPPOINTMENT OF INCUMBENT MAGISTRATE JUDGE

The current term of office of United States Chief Magistrate Judge Kelly K.E. Mahoney, who is located at the Sioux City, Iowa, courthouse, is due to expire on December 31, 2024. The United States District Court for the Northern District of Iowa is required by law to establish a panel of citizens to consider the reappointment of Judge Mahoney to a new 8-year term.

The duties of a magistrate judge in the court include but are not limited to the following: (1) conduct most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases; (2) conduct trial and dispose of misdemeanor cases; (3) conduct various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from a district judge; and (4) conduct trial and dispose of civil cases upon consent of the litigants. The basic authority of a United States magistrate judge is specified in 28 U.S.C. § 636.
