

NOTICE
Judge Mahoney's Courtroom and Chambers

Consistent with Administrative Order 20-AO-0010-P (requiring face masks or shields) and recommendations by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, persons appearing in Judge Mahoney's courtroom or chambers should take the following precautions:

FACE MASKS OR SHIELDS: Wear a **face mask or face shield** as required under Administrative Order 20-AO-0010-P.

SYMPTOMS: **Do not enter** if:

- **you are experiencing any symptoms**, including:
 - fever or chills
 - cough
 - shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - fatigue
 - muscle or body aches
 - headache
 - new loss of taste or smell
 - sore throat
 - congestion or runny nose
 - nausea or vomiting
 - diarrhea
- **you have been exposed**, within the past ten (10) days, to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19; or
- **you have been advised to quarantine** within the past ten (10) days.

SOCIAL DISTANCING: Maintain **social distancing** of at least six (6) feet from the bench and in chambers. Social distancing between persons in the courtroom is encouraged but not required.

COVER COUGHS AND SNEEZES: **Cover any coughs or sneeze with an elbow or facial tissue.** Use of hand sanitizer after coughing or sneezing is encouraged.

ACCOMODATIONS: Please advise chambers **prior to any hearing or as soon as possible** if you or a party are unable to comply with these measures (for example, an inability to wear a face mask due to a health issue).
